


RUSafe?

3: What should you do?


If you are worried about anything you could begin by talking to your mum or dad, or your coach or team manager, or me, my contact details are below.

2: What do I do?

I try to make sure that everyone who is under 18 years old is safe at the club. It doesn't matter if you are playing, watching, helping or even if we have gone to an away match or on tour. I also check all the coaches to make sure they are OK to look after you. And I try and help everyone to behave well and represent Rugby and Morpeth club.



4: What then?

If the problem is another child then I will speak to their mum or dad; if it's someone who is in charge I will speak to them or the RFU at Twickenham to help; I can also speak to the police or social services if it's really serious.



Then the Club will decide what needs to be done - we can tell them not to do it again or we can ask them to leave the club.
